**OPENING OF ENROLMENT – AITAR TRIBUNAL TRAINING PROGRAMME**

The Chief Adjudicator and President of Independent Tribunals announces the opening of enrolment for the **AITAR Tribunal Training Programme** – a structured, constitutionally grounded qualification framework for independent tribunal members under **Article 1(3) of the Constitution of Kenya**.

**Programme overview**

The Programme comprises four Tiers, covering general dispute resolution (AITAR), succession (AISTAR), and electoral dispute resolution (AIETAR). It is delivered online, self-paced, with workbook modules, training videos, assessments, and a remote marking system.

**Who may enrol**

Lawyers, quantity surveyors, accountants, engineers, and other qualified professionals. Existing AITAR Roster members may enrol in specialist modules (AISTAR, AIETAR) without completing full Tiers.

**Key features**

- Deferred Payment Scheme (DPS) – pay 15% of future appointment earnings; no upfront fee for qualifying applicants.
- Authorised Representative Programme (ARP) – formal qualification for representatives appearing before AITAR, AISTAR, and AIETAR Tribunals.
- Direct entry pathway for experienced practitioners (portfolio assessment under TPD 15/2026).

**Fees and enrolment**

**Constitutional status**

Independent tribunal members exercise delegated sovereign authority under the same Article 1(3) of the Constitution as Parliament, the executive, and the Judiciary.
